A PLACE FOR EVERYTHING

As blankets of snow deaden the sound of traffic and cover the ground in a beautiful coat of fresh white paint our minds turn inward to our homes, hoping to recreate the peace and tranquility we see outside in our spaces within. In this month's column we focus on attainable minimalism.

I have a limited budget, how would you suggest I prioritize my selections?

Regardless of if you have the most modest or scandalous budget we always suggest you begin by determining the experience you want to have in the space. Once you know how the space is to be used, select the forms necessary to fill that function. It is better to purchase fewer higher quality pieces than to have a lot of pieces that may have to be

replaced when they eventually fail. Additionally from an aesthetic standpoint a single quality piece draws a lot of attention away from less impressive pieces that surround it. Selecting neutral pieces will also allow you to swap out accessories such as pillows or candles seasonally which can allow you to change your look without consuming much space or money.

How do you know if a particular pattern will work in a room?

If we are talking about wallpaper or window treatments most companies have memo samples or swatches that you can order to take back to your space. If you want to check a specific dye-lot then potentially you can get a "CFA" (cutting for approval); however for many people attempting to visualize a

difficult. If that is the case some companies have "AR" (augmented reality" tools that serve as visualizers, or you can hire a designer or artist to create a rendering for you. That being said we always feel confident that you will achieve striking results by using beautiful materials simply. Limit the number of patterns you will use and reserve them for items you wish to draw visual attention to.

How do I make my home look like the ones I see in magazines?

While we don't recommend judging your home or yourself against the curated images presented in magazines or social media, we do recommend eliminating clutter. Store items in the space they are going to be used in and especially make sure to maintain clear paths for traffic flow around a room. It is always easier to keep items organized if they have a clearly defined space where they belong as well. In general once you have that done our next tips would be to make sure your rugs are large enough for your furniture to fit comfortably on; and that your drapery rods are hung roughly four inches from the ceiling with the drapes hanging to approximately half an inch off the floor.


